The Board of Education strives to conduct the affairs of the school district in a responsible open manner and to address the school related needs of the entire community. To this end, the board adopts the following community relations goals:

1. to listen to the comments and concerns of the residents;
2. to respond publicly to widely held concerns;
3. to publicize the accomplishments of students and staff;
4. to encourage community participation in activities and organizations that support school programs;
5. to encourage community participation on advisory committees;
6. to encourage community attendance at school functions with special consideration to senior citizens and retirees by extending "Gold Courtesy Card" privileges to them;
7. to encourage parent participation in schools;
8. to encourage the community use of the schools; and
9. to offer programs and services of interest to the community.
