

RELATIONS WITH OTHER EDUCATIONAL AGENCIES

The Board of Education encourages cooperation with other educational agencies.

Access to School Materials

Materials developed in or for the district may be made available to outside educational organizations for use or distribution when such use will reflect favorably upon the district and the community. No outside organization shall be granted exclusive access or control over material made available.

Relations with Nonpublic Schools

The Board recognizes that section 701 of the Education Law requires all school boards to purchase and loan, upon "individual request," textbooks to children residing in the district who are attending grades kindergarten through twelve in any public or nonpublic school which complies with the compulsory education law.

The following rules shall govern the loan of textbooks to such residents: textbooks shall remain the property district; textbooks shall be returned at the end of the school year; lost or destroyed textbooks shall be paid for in the same fashion as required of students attending district schools.

The Superintendent of Schools shall establish any regulations needed to implement and maintain this policy.
