

NOTICE OF MEETINGS

Notice of meetings shall be sent to all members of the Board of Education, Superintendent of Schools, and to the newspapers of the district. If a meeting is scheduled at least a week in advance, notice must be given to the public not less than 72 hours prior to the meeting.

When a meeting is scheduled less than a week in advance the Board must, to the extent practicable, announce through the newspapers and such other means as may appear appropriate, the date, time, and place of all regular and special meetings and the major topics to be discussed thereat. Such announcement shall be the responsibility of the Superintendent.
