SUGGESTED FOR ALL SUBJECTS (Only one set of each item to be used for all classes)

Items to be carried in pencil bag

from class to class:

- colored pencils
- post-it notes
- highlighters

Other items:

- heavy duty 2-pocket folder or small ½ binder (for homework)

For English you will need the following:

- one **BLUE** 1 inch binder (with pocket on inside cover)
- blue or black **pens**
- composition notebook (for English journal)
- loose-leaf paper to be kept in binder
- completed summer reading

For World Language you will need the following:

- one **WHITE** 1 inch binder
- dry erase marker
- pens and pencils
- 5 dividers
- loose-leaf paper

For Math you will need the following:

- one **RED** 2 inch binder
- 2nd pencil pouch to be kept in math binder (for calculator and ruler)
- loose-leaf paper to be kept in binder
- Recommended TI-30X IIS (Texas Instruments) calculator
- 6 inch/15cm ruler
- Pencil(s)

For Social Studies you will need the following:

- one **BLACK** 1 inch binder
- loose-leaf paper to be kept in the binder
- Pens and pencils

For Science you will need the following:

- one **GREEN** 1 inch binder (with pocket on inside cover)
- pens and pencils
- dry erase marker

Additional Team Information

73 Team Policies

1. Students will purchase the Van Antwerp Assignment Notebook at the beginning of the year. It is very helpful for parents/guardian to check this daily and ask to see the completed homework. Please send in a check to 'VAMS' for \$6.50. Students are expected to use this planner to record daily assignments.
2. Extra help: Team teachers' schedules are posted at the beginning of the week. Students who wish to come in early must get a pass the day before from a teacher. Students should not be dropped off in the morning without supervision.
3. Notebook and folder checks are due on or before the assigned due date. This assignment may be a zero if not turned in on time. In some classes, the binder check counts as a quiz/test.
4. Homework is important to monitor student progress and is the responsibility of the student. It should be done at home under supervision. Students should have a set study time and location each night. Maintaining and organizing materials, journal writing, reading, reviewing and updating notes, studying and reviewing, and keeping up with current events, should be part of this time (Note: 7A math students may need additional time each night).
5. Lockers are to be used on a daily basis at designated times. Lockers should be cleaned out at least once per quarter. Students must use the locks provided for them by the school. Locks must be on lockers and locked at all times. Students are responsible for the locks throughout the year and will be assessed a \$12 fee if lost.
6. Class absences: When absent from class, the **student is responsible** for making up all class work, class notes, and homework. Students should first check with their homework partner. If your child is absent for more than two days, please contact the counseling center (370-4425) for assigned work. Please make homework requests 24 hours in advance.
7. Field Trip Permission Slips: The district requires we use a standard form with specific information pertinent to your child's safety for each trip. Students must use the forms provided. If your child will not be attending a trip, a note in writing must be provided.
8. In an effort to teach our students about responsibility and completing work in a timely matter, late work will be accepted, but full credit will not be given. The work submitted must be the student's work and not work that has been copied from another student, the board, or falsified from any source, including online translators.
9. The Parent Portal is a valuable tool to view your child's progress. It is the same login information that was provided at the start of 6th grade. If you need access, please contact our Counseling Department.
